Klári Tolnay is one of the most famous hungarian actresses of the XX. century. The memorial exhibition presenting her life is operated by the association named Her. The association aims to create an intellectual workshop, art and culture promotion, which allows the broadest sense of art and artistic and cultural activities, with special attention to the drama and its promotional activities.

The memorial house receives visitors from March to October every year.

There are more than 300 original photos about Klari Tolnay's becoming an artist and the creation of art in progress. The clothes of the rich theatrical career and her awards also were given a place on the museum's walls.

In 2004, the Podium was set up, which has numerous theatrical performances, chamber concerts, bookshows.

In the Gallery of the Memorial house numerous exhibitions of the fine arts organized in the wholt year. The birthday of Klair Jolnay is celebrated in every year with commemoration event that is worthy of Her unforgettable course of life. Due the activity of the association a cultural jewel-box operates in Mohora organizing concerts of classic and light music, premiere of books, performances, seasonal exhibitions.
